





And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind... Rom 12:2 NKJV

Babylon is a representation of "Satan's city" which is controlled by the harlot, representing those following the spirit of antichrist; just as the "New Jerusalem" represents the "city of God" and those who follow Jesus Christ [see Rev 17:3-6,9]. I believe the seven mountains mentioned in the above text are world systems using Satan's hidden agendas and his bewitching tactics to control the minds of men through his antichrist deceptive influence to superimpose a...

- **World wide view**... through the media, arts, entertainment and educational systems.
- **World wide order**... through commerce, political and false religious systems.
- **World wide deception**... upon cultures and families.

The only way to deal with the anti-christ **world wide view—world wide order—world wide deception** is through preaching the **genuine gospel** of Jesus Christ. Those who promote the gospel of "Societal Transformation" are relegating Jesus Christ and His Gospel to a mere *belief system* meant to transform systems, organizations and people groups. One such advocate teaches that Jesus said, "Go into the entire world, [meaning] all its systems [7 mountains], its mind molders and its Nations and infiltrate the world with My power [signs and wonders] and teachings

[commandments]. Go through the door of globalization- world economics- and while it is yet day, while opportunity exists, penetrate these nations and systems with a demonstration of a belief system that has superior power and results. This is what Daniel did in Babylon and what Joseph did in Egypt. This is a large part of the reason why God is blowing on the marketplace message in this hour. This is a day where third world nations are asking for help, and developing nations are seeking to trade. The window is wide open to the church to impact the world. Opportunity is everywhere." 1

This man who is preaching the transformation gospel tells us we are to transform organizations and whole nations by **covertly** getting them to follow the teachings of Christ! He goes on to say: "That's right- you can be covert! One friend of mine is transforming entire schools and businesses by applying certain key commandments to his client's lives and systems. They are not even aware of the degree to which [they or] their organizations are being aligned with the teachings of Christ. All they know is that it's working. In schools the students are getting better grades and discipline problems are on the decline. In business the people are starting to work like real teams and treating each other with respect. Companies are prospering. It works! [Emphasis, brackets & underline mine]"

Jesus Christ and His gospel is not a belief system that is to be practiced *covertly* so that students can behave better, get better grades, or cause companies to prosper or help people groups to come out of poverty! Jesus did not come to transform society and make the world a nicer or

better place in which to live. He came to save sinners so they would not end up in hell for eternity! ...*Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners.*

[1 Tim 1:15] KJV

The true gospel will let people know they are sinners and that they need saving from hell's eternal punishment... *But I'll tell you whom to fear. Fear God, who has the power to kill people and then throw them into hell.*

Luke 12:5 NLT

Every person is going to face God in judgment. We as Bible believing Christians are not doing the work of our ministry, if we are not preparing people for this by preaching the true gospel of repentance from sin and faith in Jesus Christ. Likewise Christian ministers are not doing the work of the ministry if they are not equipping believers to preach and teach this true gospel message. We are not called to transform governments, school systems, the media or arts; we are called to transform people by getting them to agree with truth concerning their eternal destiny! We are told:

To open their eyes so they may turn from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God. Then they will receive forgiveness for their sins and be given a place among God's people, who are set apart by faith in me.'

Acts 26:18 NLT

Many are redefining the kingdom of God. The Apostle Paul said this...*For the kingdom of God is... righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.*

Rom 14:17 KJV

Telling people how to get right with God by repenting of sin, so they can have peace and joy is the Gospel message Jesus preached... *Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God...and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."*

hell and be right with God. Instead they are being taught to demonstrate change without openly proclaiming Christ as the only way to be changed. When we deny Jesus Christ His rightful place, and think we can covertly preach His teachings, we are in essence denying Him! The ends never justify the means. I don't care how many governments, schools, businesses or entertainment and media systems we transform, if we are not saving people from eternal damnation, we are following a false gospel. Too many professing Christians are waning in their faith and fear of God; because they are deceived into thinking they can bring social, economic and religious reforms through man made philosophies. I find it alarming to see so many Christians putting their time, energy and valuable resources into political and government agendas, in the belief that they are called to bring *restoration* and *reform* in the earth. The Apostle Paul made it clear that all things would be *restored* and totally *reformed* when it was time for Jesus Christ to come back to earth and set up His literal earthly kingdom. There will be no societal transformation until that happens [Acts 3:21]. Until then, all servants of Jesus Christ are to preach and share the gospel of His Kingdom while we still have time to do so. Unfortunately there are false teachers and prophets who are preaching *another gospel* called the societal transformation gospel. Robert Archiquette, in the following article from his *Watching On the Walls* publication states: "*When Christians team up with...the ways of national or*

community programs and with unsaved people...they are drawn by coalitions of... government movements to fight for political, economic or social reforms... In essence, these deceived Christians see charitable works mixed with reform as a means to "change" society and commerce... those who lust for this power to bring change, are being drawn... into a more evil agenda [that of the antichrist].² [Brackets Mine]

I see Christians being bewitched by charismatic political commentators and analysts who are causing them to become focused on what has nothing to do with their commission to preach and share the gospel of repentance from sin and faith in Jesus Christ. I also see many professing Christians who have more fervor and passion for politics and the affairs of this present world than they do for God's word and ways. We are in a war against the deception of our enemy Satan. I can't help but think of what the Apostle Paul told us concerning our duty as true followers and warriors for Jesus Christ...

And as Christ's soldier, do not let yourself become entangled in the affairs of this life, for then you cannot satisfy the one who has enlisted you in his army... Follow the Lord's rules for doing his work... [2 Tim 2:4-5] NLT [Underline Mine] ●
